### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Check your cot regularly. Retighten all bolts. For customers care contact Grotime Australia on 1300 92 4632; or New Zealand on 067 590 870

Do not use abrasive or corrosive agents, lint free cloth and then wipe with a dry cloth.

### **RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE**

This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measures 690mm wide by 1300mm long and 130mm in thickness. The width and length are specified because it is important that the gaps between the mattress and the sides of the cot will not exceed 40mm when the mattress is pushed to one side or end, and 20mm when the mattress is centred in the cot. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the it is greater than 500mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimise the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

To store your Cot (30222), please reverse assembly steps. Ensure all components are kept together along with Instruction manual for future use.





Step 1. Unpack Contents.


**Step 2.** Assemble Legs (8) to Frame A (6) using 4 x 40mm Bolts (B) and Wood Dowel (E).



## ASSEMBLY

#### Step 3.


Create upper assembly with Cot End (A), Cot End (B) & Cot Rail (C) using 4 x 65mm Bolts. Then connect the upper assembly to the lower assembly from step 2 using 7 x 65mm Bolts.




- Do not tighten bolts at this stage
- Choose high or low position for mattress base

## ASSEMBLY


**Step 4.** Correctly position the Mattress Base (5) as per Figure 4A. Highest Position is used for Infant Mode and the Lowest Position is used for Toddler Mode. Screw Mattress base in place using 40mm Bolts. Fill finger entrapments with 4 x 15mm Bolts (C) and D.Nut (D).






### ASSEMBLY

**Step 5.** Prepare drop side assembly by inserting the 4 x Guide Pins (F) correctly into the 2 Cot End panels.






Align two access holes in the built-in runner with the guide pins on one end. Now repeat on the other end.




Ensure correct side is facing out

## ASSEMBLY

**Step 6.** Assemble the drop side sub assembly of the cot by screwing Drop Side Cot Rail (4) to Frame B (7), using 3 x 65mm Bolts (A).




**Step 7.** Complete assembly of your cot by connecting the drop side sub assembly to the two ends of the cot. Align the Guide Pins (F) appropriately with the slots on the drop side.



### ASSEMBLY

Step 8. Tighten all bolts.




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### OPERATION

To lower drop side, lift from centre of top rail, hold side in that position while using your leg to push inward on centre of bottom rail. Then allow to slide gently down.
