CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Check your cot regularly. Re-tighten all bolts. For customers care contact Grotime Australia on 1300 92 4632; or New Zealand on 067 590 870

Do not use abrasive or corrosive agents, lint free cloth and then wipe with a dry cloth.

RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE

This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measures 690mm wide by 1300mm long and 130mm in thickness. The width and length are specified because it is important that the gaps do not exceed 40mm when the mattress is pushed to one side or end, and 20mm when the mattress is centred in the cot. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of cot is greater than 500mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimise the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

To store your Cot (30234/30235), please reverse assembly steps. Ensure all components are kept together along with Instruction manual for future use.







PRE-INSTALLED HARDWARE



Locking Bolts


PARTS INVENTORY








Assemble fixed sides to end panels using 4 x 65mm bolts.

STEP 2


Assemble Cot Base using 4 x 65mm bolts.




TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MATTRESS BASE OF THIS COT SHOULD BE ADJUSTED TO THE LOWEST POSITION

BEFORE CHILD CAN SIT UP.

Screw four guide pins into the End Panels firmly






STEP 4

ASSEMBLE DROP SIDE


Align two access holes in the built-in runner with the guide pins on one end. Now repeat on other end.



FULLY SCREW IN LOCKING BOLTS

a: Lift drop side up until it clicks into the locking position.


b: Tighten Locking bolts






OPERATION


To lower drop side, lift from centre of top rail, hold side in that position while using your leg to push inward on centre of bottom rail. Then allow to slide gently down.



Plug finger entrapments using 4 x 16mm Bolts
